



# SIGHT WORDS

Parents participate by reading activity flash cards while children use a rechargeable flashlight named Poindexter to light the words. It's especially fun at bedtime when the lights are out.

## Learning Activities:

1. Read and practice words until learned by sight.
2. Choose one or more words and make a complete sentence.
3. Choose a word and use it in the form of a question.
4. Read a word for your child and have him or her repeat it and find it. You can give clues such as the starting letter or color of the word.
5. Play GUESS MY WORD: "It's a green word and has 5 letters. It starts with...."
6. Choose one or more words and create a story. Using your imagination is higher level thinking.
