



RHYMING PAIRS

Parents participate by reading activity flash cards while children use a rechargeable flashlight named Poindexter to light the words. It's especially fun at bedtime when the lights are out.

Learning Activities:

1. Pair each word from the top with its rhyming word at the bottom.
2. Practice recognizing words.
3. Think of more rhyming words (real or make-believe).
4. Choose a word and use it in a sentence.
5. Practice your colors.
6. Read a word for your child and have him or her repeat it and find it. You can give clues such as the starting letter or color of the word.
7. Play GUESS MY WORD: "It's a red word and has four letters. It starts with..."
